Literacy

This week we have been focusing on our reading skills in phonics. We have been reading short stories where children read with their partners. Children are developing their comprehension skills as we are asking them questions about the story to extend their learning. We have also been working on sentence writing and reminding the children to use capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

Maths

Maths this week has been fun and engaging. We have been consolidating the concept of 'addition' and practising counting on in our heads. Children were magicians, having to place the first number in their heads then adding another number to make a sum. Encourage children to put the bigger number in their heads and add on. E.g. $12+4$.

Patty the Pirate came into class with a treasure box filled with sums. He challenged the children to complete the sums and they really enjoyed getting the correct answers.
