### Who was given a special coat?

Yosef was given a special coat. Yosef was the son of Yaakov and Rachel. He was Yaakov's favourite son. Yaakov gave Yosef a beautiful coat as a gift and this made his brothers jealous of him.



### Who had two dreams?

Yosef had two dreams. In the first one, the sun, moon and stars bowed down to him. In the second dream the wheat belonging to Yosef's brothers bowed down to Yosef's own wheat. When Yosef told his brothers about his dreams their hatred towards him grew.



### Who was sold as a slave?
