Our Learning This Week

Kitta Bet have had a very exciting week! They were given a sneak preview of the new school and the new Year 2 classrooms - they even got to discuss how they would like the new classrooms to look. After the wonderful Fire of London workshop, the children created their own freeze frames in the style of comic strips. To celebrate Chinese New Year, we were lucky enough to have a presentation by Yimeng's mother, Dr Chen, and then the children made their own Chinese pellet drums, and added decorations in the style of Chinese symbols.

Literacy

This week, in Literacy, we have been applying our learning around our text Halibut Jackson to plan and write our own diary entries in the role of Halibut. We made sure to use the past tense, interesting adjectives, conjunctions, and lots of exciting vocabulary.

Maths

This week in Maths, the children used skip counting to work out multiplications of 10 and used this to help solve multiplication word problems. The children then applied their learning of the 2, 5 and 10 times tables to investigate patterns in multiples of 2, 5 and 10. They then went on to solve missing number multiplication and division problems to help them crack a code.
