In this week's Parashah, we follow the fortunes of Yosef, the eldest son of Yaakov's wife, Rachel. Over a period of time, Yosef becomes increasingly disliked by his brothers. He tells tales about them to their father and persists in sharing with them his dreams of superiority over the family. In so doing, he shows insensitivity to their feelings and, ultimately, the brothers sell him to traders headed for Mitzrayim (Egypt). In Egypt, he fares well until he is framed by Potifar's wife and thrown into prison. It is there that we see Yosef develop his sensitivity to others' feelings. Noticing the saddened faces of the butler and the baker, his fellow prisoners, he offers to help them and interprets their dreams.

In class we have discussed the importance of being sensitive to the feelings of others.
